





Let me first take the privilege of introducing the Dr. A.P.J. Abdul Kalam Centre for Creating Livable Planet and Sustainable Development. The Centre aims to create and implement mission-mode projects along with the mission and vision of Dr. A.P.J. Abdul Kalam (1931-2015), the 11th President of India. It aims to promote innovations, especially in governance and social enterprises, improve youth participation in national and international development and improve access to education and knowledge in all strata of the society. The Centre stands to take forward the dreams of Dr. Kalam, which he left behind for the nation and world – right upto his very final moment, at IIM Shillong. The board of the Center includes luminaries such as Shri Desh Deepak Verma (Secretary General Rajya Sabha), Shri Alok Ranjan (Former Chief Secretary, Uttar Pradesh), Padma Bhushan Dr. S.B. Mujumdar, Dr. Dilip Rath (Chairman, NDDB) and Dr. Ashok Patil (World's First Vice Chancellor of Rural Medical University).

The Centre has organized several conclaves dedicated to Dr. Kalam and his missions which have been participated by guests including Shri Ram Naik (Honorable Governor), His Holiness Jagadguru Sri Sri Sri Dr. Nirmalanandanath Swamiji (Head, Adichunchanagari Math), Dr. Rajiv Kumar (Vice Chairman NITI Aayog), Nobel Laureate Dr. Kailash Satyarthi, Shri Akhilesh Yadav, Shri Jayant Sahasrabuddhe (National Organizing Secretary, Vijnana Bharati), Ms. Dia Mirza, Mr. Javagal Srinath, Mr. Arunachalam Muruganantham, Mr. Anshu Gupta, Dr. Kiran Bedi, Dr. S.Y. Quraishi (Former Chief Election Commissioner of India) and hundreds of international and national delegates.

On 15th of October 2016, which marked the 85th birth anniversary of Dr. A.P.J. Abdul Kalam, the Centre celebrated the occasion by organizing India's first of its kind award on innovations in governance space – under the banner of Dr. Kalam Innovation In Governance Awards or KIGA. This summit and award was a step in the direction of exploring how cutting-edge technology, 21st century management can and out-of-box thinking, transform the role and impact of governance in India and across the world. Over 60 senior bureaucrats, police officers, administrators and business body leaders participated in this summit and shared their views on improving governance and administration with the audience. The awardees included Shri K. Srinivas (IAS), Shri Ashwani Lohani (Chairman, Indian Railway Board and former MD, Air India), Shri Mahesh Gupta (Chairman & MD, Kent RO Systems), Shri Javeed Ahmed (DGP, Uttar Pradesh) and many others.

The second edition of the summit was conducted on January 20, 2018 at Vigyan Bhavan in New Delhi where over 40 top officers, police officers, diplomats and experts in governance assembled and shared ideas with a crowd of 400 selected invitees. Minister of State for Textiles Shri Ajay Tamta and former Secretary General of the Rajya Sabha Shri Desh Deepak Verma felicitated the awardees. Other significant guests and awardees included Shri Pankaj Kumar (Additional Chief Secretary, Revenue Dept), Shri Anuj Dayal (Executive Director, DMRC) and Shri Dnyaneshwar Mulay, Secretary MEA (CPV & OIA).

Continuing on the missions of Dr. Kalam, the Centre is now organizing the 3rd edition of the Dr. A.P.J. Abdul Kalam Summit on Innovation and Governance in March 2019 in New Delhi where innovative public services personnel, including IAS, IPS officers, PSU leaders, business body leaders and administrative studies related researchers and academicians shall be participating. During the summit, we will initiate plenary discussions on: Sustainable Development and Transparent Governance.

The summit will also feature the 3rd edition of Dr. A.P.J. Abdul Kalam Award for Innovation in Governance to be presented to selected individuals and institutions for their exemplary work in improving governance.
