The Governor of Himachal Pradesh is pleased to constitute the following Committees to carry out inspection of roads in accordance with the guidelines worked out in a joint meeting of the officials of the Govt. of HP and Ministry of Environment of Forests, Govt. of India held on 19.08.2013 in pursuance of the orders dated 8th August and 5th September, 2013 of Hon'ble High Court of Himachal Pradesh in CWP No.5600 of 2012, CWP No.9797 of 2012 and COPC No.56 of 2009:-

I) ROAD PROPOSALS IN WHICH NO FURTHER CONSTRUCTION IS REQUIRED

1. Divisional Forest Officer of the area : Chairman
2. Representative of Deputy Commissioner : Member
(not below the rank of SDM)
3. Executive Engineer of the area : Member Secretary

The terms of reference of the Committee are as under:-

- i) Carry out inspection of all roads referred to in the orders of the Hon'ble High Court of H.P. in CWP No.5600 of 2012, CWP No.9797 of 2012 and COPC No.56 of 2009.
ii) Give a detailed report, road wise, on the violation also indicating the extent of violation.
iii) Indicate road wise measures required, if any, for strengthening the ecology of the area.

II) ROAD PROPOSALS REQUIRING ADDITIONAL WORKS TO BE UNDERTAKEN

1. Conservator of Forests of the area : Chairman
2. Superintending Engineer of the area : Member
3. Divisional Forest Officer of the area : Member
4. Representative of Deputy Commissioner : Member
(not below the rank of SDM)
5. Executive Engineer of the area : Member Secretary

The terms of reference of the Committee are as under:-

- i) Carry out inspection of all roads referred to in the orders of the Hon'ble High Court of H.P. in CWP No.5600 of 2012, CWP No.9797 of 2012 and COPC No.56 of 2009.
- ii) Give a detailed report, road wise, on the violation also indicating the extent of violation.
- iii) Indicate necessity of undertaking construction of the remaining part yet to be constructed and explore possibility of including minimum forest land/trees for the remaining part.
- iv) Indicate road wise measures required, if any, for strengthening the ecology of the area.

The Member Secretary shall ensure that a minimum of three roads are inspected by the Committee(s) every month in each Forest Division and road wise report is submitted to the concerned DFO within one week of the date of inspection.
