Sub: Regarding regulation of payments to the contractors during the 5 years Maintenance Period in respect of RRP-II works. Standard Formats thereof.

Sir,

Please refer to the clause 38.2 of Model Bidding Document for RRP-II stage-II, the contractors has to carry out compulsory 5 year Routine maintenance of road they constructed. There is no standard format as to how the Routine Maintenance activities and Payments to be regulated. Since, about 30 no. works have already been completed in RRP-II; this office has devised two formats as under:

1. Format-I (Monthly statement of Routine Maintenance)
2. Format-II (Six monthly Routine Maintenance & Payment due to contractor)

You are requested to circulate the above formats for regulation of payments for Routine maintenance of RRP-II roads. On the basis of Format-II the payments can be made to contractor. The clause 32.2, 38.2 of GCC, 7(c) of Contract data of Modal Bidding document and Annexure 12 of Procurement and Contract Management Manual (PCMM) may be kept in mind while using these formats.
